Virtual competitions delivered on your school site and personal challenges from sports around the world.

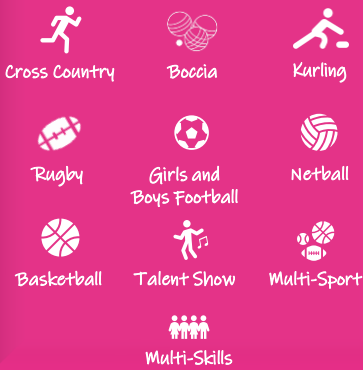
## Birmingham School Games Vision
