Sports Leadership

Our Sports Leaders offer gives young people the opportunity to develop their leadership skills over the course of the year, following a series of deliveries within your school.

Our Sports Leadership programme starts at Year 4 and progresses up to Year 6. Year 6 pupils who complete the KESSP training will then filter into our leadership programmes in Year 7 in our local partner secondary schools. We aim to give all pupils the opportunity to learn and grow their leadership skills, even when they move beyond your school.

Our Steps to Success programme has now reached over 1000 young people across the partnership and the city of Birmingham. This year, we will be delivering our first SEND Shooting Stars Festival. Come along and find out what it is all about!



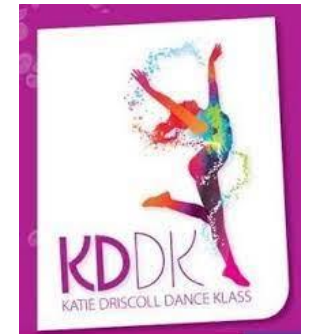
