## Event Format

Number of Pupils: 5-a-side

Year Group: Year 4-6

Venue: Power League, Salford Stadium, Lichfield Rd, Birmingham B6 7TG

Time: 1 - 3pm, 4 - 5.30pm

Date: 20<sup>th</sup> September 2023

- Corners are as per normal football rules.
- If the ball goes over the sideline, play is started with the ball being kicked in from the point it went of the pitch.
- Goalkeepers can play as they would in a normal game. If the ball is passed back to them, them cannot pick it up.
  - Goalkeepers cannot kick the ball out of their hands.
  - There is no slide tackling.
