These events focus on the development of character and life skills through our leadership pathways.

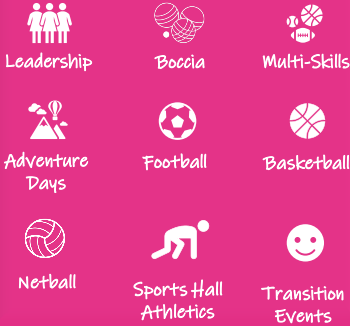
Birmingham School Games Vision
