Number of Pupils: 5-a-side

Year Group: Year 4-6

Venue: Trinity Road, Aston, Birmingham, B6 6LS

Time: 9.30 - 1pm

Date: 3rd July 2025

- Corners are as per normal football rules.
- If the ball goes over the sideline, play is started with the ball being kicked in from the point it went of the pitch.
- Goalkeepers can play as they would in a normal game. If the ball is passed back to them, they cannot pick it up.
 - Goalkeepers cannot kick the ball out of their hands.
 - There is no slide tackling.
