Engage events have a focus on engagement, competition or a blend of both. We want young people to feel inspired and enthused and ready to make the most of the opportunities around them.

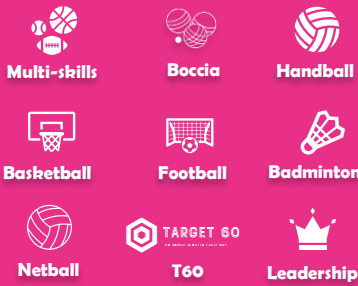


Compete events are aimed at young people who want to compete with others. Win medals and test yourself against other schools!
