COMPETE

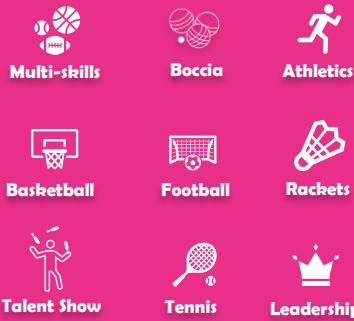
Compete events are aimed at young people who want to compete with others. Win medals and test yourself against other schools!
